The millennium of Ferdowsi

Abolghasem Ferdowsi, the great Iranian and world epic poet was born in the 4th Hijri century (1100 years ago) in Toos which is one of the biggest cities of Khorasan. He was interested in poetry from childhood and he composed poems when he was a youngster. Great poets of that period could not compose like him. His unique and universal work 'The Book of Kings' has 60,000 verses which have been composed in Mathnavi. The most famous parts of 'The Book of Kings' are 'Haft Khane-e-Rustam', 'Rustam va Sohrab', 'Rustam va Esfandiar', 'Rustam va Afrasiab', 'Bijan va Manijeh' and 'The Story of Siavash'. Ferdowsi has made a great contribution to the glorious history and culture of Iran, and also he has had a massive impact on perpetuating the Persian language. It should be mentioned that in 'The Book of Kings' only 650 Arabic words have been used.

GCSE & A-level exams Results

GCSE and A-level exams were held at Rustam School in May & June 2010. The results of GCSE students were excellent as 18 out of 19 students achieved A* grade and one grade A. The results of A-level candidates were excellent too. 15 out of 17 AS students achieved grade A and out of 10 A2 candidates, 3 students achieved A* and 4 students A. It is worth mentioning that this year was the first year of A2 exam with the new OCR specification and the second year of AS.

We are all very proud of these students for their fantastic achievement. We also take this opportunity to thank Christ's College for their co-operation in holding the exams.
